4th Annual Photography Contest



The Friends of Mary Cummings Park invite you to participate in the 4th Annual Photography Contest! Last year's contest was so successful we have extended the deadline to include winter and spring photographs!

Photographs may depict anything in the park, such as wildlife and nature, people having fun in the park, or scenic pictures. The size of the photograph may be no larger than 9" x 12" and matted (framing optional), with a maximum of three (3) entries per photographer.

All contest entries will be accepted at the Ritz Camera of Woburn on 103 Commerce Way through March 1, 2012 and should include the photographer's name, home address, e-mail, phone number and division :

- (1) Adult,
- (2) High School
- (3) Middle School/Elementary students.

The awards ceremony will take place in the Spring of 2012 at a time, date and location to be determined. Awards and prizes will be given of \$100, \$50, and \$25 for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners, respectively. Photographs entered will be exhibited at area libraries for public viewing. Photographers who submit their photos before November 5, 2011 will have the opportunity to have their photos displayed at the South Boston Public Library for the month of December at the Mary Cummings Park Photo Exhibit.

Mary Cummings Park is the 12th largest public parkland inside of Route 128 and is located in Burlington and Woburn, off of the Cambridge Street town line. Its 210 acres of woodlands, wetlands, and meadows provide wonderful opportunities for recreation and artistic creation.
